ELECTION INSPECTORS
RESOLUTION NO. 2-2003

WHEREAS Wisconsin Statutes Section 7.30 provides for seven (7) inspectors at each polling place at each election except where voting machines are used, in which case the municipality may reduce the number of inspectors to five (5);

AND WHEREAS Wisconsin Statutes Section 7.32 provides that the governing body of a municipality may by resolution reduce the number of election officials further to no less than three (3) election officials at each polling place;

AND WHEREAS the Town Board of the Town of Gardner has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town of Gardner to allow the number of election officials to be set at a minimum of three (3) such officials;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Gardner does hereby adopt the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes Section 7.32 providing that the number of election officials shall be not less than three (3) such election officials at each election.
